- 1. Chapel Down Sparkling Bacchus. Kent, England** £37.00
Bacchus is the Ancient Greek god of wine and he's lent his name to what is now England's star grape. It's a glorious streak of pineapple, grapefruit and elderflower that runs through arrow-precise bubbles.
- 2. Bel Canto Prosecco. Italy** £6.20 £27.50
Delicate and aromatic with fine bubbles. This wine carries lots of fresh peach, pear, apple, melon and an elegant zest.
- 3. Taittinger Brut Reserve. Champagne, France** £70.00
Aged in the oldest cellars in Champagne, this elegant Champagne weaves notes of peach, acacia, citrus and honey through the divine bubbles that lead to a beautiful finish.
- 4. Ruinart Blanc de Blancs. Champagne, France** £100.00
Grand Cru Chardonnay simply makes the best Champagne. Citrus, peach and white flower aromas evolve into a fresh and supple palate. Perfect when married with oysters or seafood.
- 5. Hambledon Classic Cuvée. Hampshire, England** £60.00
Hambledon is the UK's oldest commercial vineyard, and its head winemaker, Hervé Jestin, was cellar master at the Duval Leroy Champagne house for over 20 years. The Classic Cuvée, a blend of Chardonnay, Pinot Noir & Pinot Meunier, once famously beat Pol Roger, Veuve Clicquot and Taittinger in a blind tasting. It has notes of fresh bread, greengage, red plums and dessert apples and a precise acidity.
- 6. Paul Drouet Brut. Champagne, France** £11.00 £50.00
Apple and brioche lead the way in this medium bodied, fruity and classically biscuity style of Champagne.
- 7. Taittinger Rosé. Champagne, France** £80.00
A blend of wines from several harvests, with a delightful pink hue in colour and a nose of fresh red berries. It is well balanced, with a fine mousse, and subtle red fruit flavours on the palate.

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| 8. Baron de Baussac Viognier. Southern France
A fleshy white with a beautifully elegant texture, bright aromas of ripe apricot and peach, hints of grapefruit and fresh pineapple. | £7.50 | £10.35 | £28.00 |
| 9. Lyrarakis Assyrtiko. Greece
This is balanced and crisp, with flavours of green apple, citrus and stone fruits. | | | £31.50 |
| 10. Mozzafiato Falanghina. Italy
Light straw yellow with greenish reflections; It is fresh and fruity to the nose with notes of citrus, pineapple and white flowers. | | | £27.00 |
| 11. Languore Trebbiano, Chardonnay. Italy
Straw-yellow with light greenish hue in colour, this wine is intense on the nose, with notes of tropical fruit and a hint of vanilla. Structured and full on the palate, it is smooth and well balanced. | £5.50 | £7.60 | £20.50 |
| 12. San Giorgio Pinot Grigio. Italy
This is a crisp white with invigorating citrus fruit. Honeysuckle meets pear drop notes for a balanced palate. | £6.85 | £9.45 | £25.50 |
| 13. Dominio de la Fuente Verdejo. Spain ORGANIC
A crisp, aromatic white wine, showing great purity of aromas. Bright, pale straw yellow, with intense, fresh notes of grass, fennel and white pepper. | £6.30 | £8.70 | £23.50 |
| 14. Balade Romantique Sauvignon Blanc. Southern France
This wine has a lovely pale yellow colour. On the nose it exhibits delicate aromas of blackcurrant leaf, apple and gooseberry. On the palate it is elegant, crisp, refreshing and aromatic. | £6.70 | £9.25 | £25.00 |
| 15. Sancerre Blanc Duc Armand. France
Elegant dry white wine, pale yellow colour, aromas of white flowers and green apple and refreshing citrus flavours. | | | £54.00 |
| 16. Fernlands Sauvignon Blanc. New Zealand
Wonderful balance between tropical and herbaceous flavours. Gooseberry and green pepper mingle with mango and guava. | | | £35.00 |

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| <p>17. Winzer Krems Grüner Veltliner. <i>Austria</i></p> <p>Crisp and refreshing, this fine Gruner abounds in flavours of peach and citrus and finishes with notes of minerals and pepper.</p> | £26.50 |
| <p>18. Lua Nova Vinho Verde. <i>Portugal</i></p> <p>This wine is fresh, zesty and zippy. On the nose there are notes of white flowers, and on the palate tropical and stone fruit.</p> | £26.00 |
| <p>19. Macon-Villages La Cave d'Azé. <i>Burgundy, France</i></p> <p>Intense and subtle nose of mango, pineapple, hazelnut and grilled almond. Freshness and elegant taste of citrus and ripe nectarines for a perfect balance with a beautiful minerality.</p> | £35.50 |
| <p>20. Main Divide Riesling, Pegasus Bay, Waipara.
<i>New Zealand</i></p> <p>Slightly off-dry in style, the palate is attacked with wave after wave of honeysuckle, ripe apricot and lime, with a minerally undercurrent and zippy acidity.</p> | £35.00 |
| <p>21. Bantry Bay Chenin Blanc. <i>South Africa</i></p> <p>A fresh wine showing delicate floral notes and subtle pineapple fruit, joined by striking lemon and grapefruit flavours.</p> | £22.00 |
| <p>22. Chablis 1er Cru Fourchaume, Domaine L. Chatelain.
<i>Burgundy</i></p> <p>Fourchaume is one of the most acclaimed spots in Chablis. Exposed to the rising sun, vines here see bucketloads of grape plumping hours. Here, you'll find Chablis that's powerful and elegant, standing toe to toe with the finest Grand Crus. Domaine L. Chatelain's is a prime example. On the nose, it emits delicate hints of almond, butter and licorice. The palate is round and buttery with flavours of citrus, marmalade and toasted almond.</p> | £65.00 |
| <p>23. Valle Berta Gavi. <i>Italy</i></p> <p>Subtle traces of honeysuckle with characteristic aromas of lime zest and minerality. It offers a clean and refreshing finish.</p> | £29.00 |

<i>France</i></p> <p>Rosé with a beautiful colour with lychee hues. On the nose, it is both fine and elegant with red berry notes. The palate attack is round and marked by red berry aromas.</p> | £30.50 | | |
| <p>25. Viertalo Tempranillo Garnacha Rosé. <i>Spain</i></p> <p>A fresh, ripe strawberry fruit character make this an approachable style of rosé.</p> | £5.30 | £7.20 | £19.50 |

27. Tierra Plata Malbec. Argentina £6.85 £9.45 £25.50

This is a big and bold Malbec leads with intense fruit. The oak gives a vanilla character and the small component of Cabernet provides a serious backbone to this wine with velvety soft tannins.

28. Domaine des Tourelles 'Cuvée Pierre Brun'. Lebanon £35.00

Founded in 1868, Tourelles is Lebanon's oldest winery. A blend of Cabernet, Syrah, Cinsault and Carignan, this has fine aromatic morello cherry and spice aromas, a dark fruit core with layered earthy spice, and balanced tannins.

29. Conde de Castille Reserva. Rioja, Spain £30.50

A complex Rioja with the perfect age to display a harmonious blend of dried, stewed fruits and nuances of leather, vanilla and tobacco.

30. The Old Gum Tree Shiraz. Australia £6.15 £8.50 £23.00

This is a classic fruit driven Shiraz with intense, ripe raspberry and cherry flavours with overtones of vanilla and spice.

31. Flor del Fuego Cabernet Sauvignon. Chile £5.90 £8.15 £22.00

Stewed blackcurrant and plum, with a cassis-like concentration. Fulsome tannins make this a bold and rich red.

32. Five Ravens Pinot Noir. Romania £6.55 £9.05 £24.50

Romania may not be the first place you think of when you are looking to buy a Pinot Noir, but East Europe offers exceptional value and quality. This has all the classic bright red fruit flavours and spicy notes you'd expect.

33. Languore Sangiovese. Italy £5.50 £7.60 £20.50

Intense ruby red in colour with typical scents of ripe cherry and raspberry. It is medium bodied, juicy, fresh and persistent.

34. Merlot Reserva, Terra Vega. Chile £6.30 £8.70 £23.50

The wine delivers a solid core of concentrated fruit, hinting at blackberry preserves and damson plums.

35. Grati Chianti. Italy £28.00

Full of vibrant cherry and strawberry fruit, with violet undertones. A traditional and rustic Chianti.

36. Olivier Maurice Côtes du Rhône. France £25.00

Mid red colour with darker purple notes. Attractive red berry nose, with hints of spice. Lovely fruit entry on the palate with plenty of red and black berry flavours, overlaid with a hint of spice. Soft supple tannins and a lift of acidity give the wine length and complexity.

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| <p>37. Esprit de Lussac. Bordeaux, France</p> <p>Juicy black fruit on the nose and cranberry nuances on the palate, tied together with a smoky sandalwood character.</p> <p>38. Les Clefs du Cellier Châteauneuf-du-Pape.
Bordeaux, France</p> <p>A garnet-red wine with aromas of fresh red fruits, spices and a hint of chocolate. The palate is silky smooth with a powerful fruit intensity and wonderful complexity.</p> <p>39. Dominio de la Fuente Garnacha. Spain ORGANIC</p> <p>A juicy, fleshy unoaked red wine, showing great purity and the typicity of high-altitude Garnacha from the heart of Spain, with expressive and well-defined aromas of red fruits and violets. Bright ruby red colour.</p> <p>40. Ch Ste Michelle Cabernet Sauvignon.
Washington, USA</p> <p>Notes of cedar and vanilla follow on to the silky smooth finish that lingers on the palate with the black currant and plum.</p> <p>41. Amarone Classico ‘Vigneti di Roccolo’, Cantina Negrar. Italy</p> <p>Brooding, deep, intense aromas of Christmas cake, chocolate, cinnamon, sweet fruits and spice. The concentrated palate offers a thick texture and soft velvety tannins, very rich fruit characteristics.</p> <p>42. Wisdom Tree Dao. Bordeaux, France</p> <p>With seductive aromas of fragrant orange blossom, spices and fudge.
